

For guidance counselors or teachers: Statements

This is an exercise that can be used in a group, before or after the Reality Check!

The aim is for students to broaden their perspectives and connect the Reality Check they are conducting or will conduct with their own thoughts and feelings regarding future study and career choices. The exercise often leads to good discussions where different thoughts can be discussed.

It is important that a teacher or guidance counselor leads the discussion. A good way is to show the statements on a large screen one at a time!

Are these statements true?

If you have more education, you should have a higher salary

Some jobs are only suitable for boys

Girls are better suited to work with children

The most important thing is what you earn, not what you contribute

Theoretical education is better than practical

Nobody would work if they got money anyway
